- BAT (bats sleep in caves)
- CALCITE (the mineral that cave formations are made of)
- CAVE (a natural hole in the ground)
- COLUMN (a cave formation that goes from ceiling to floor)
- CRYSTAL (piece of mineral, sometimes sparkles)
- ENSATINA (cave salamander)
- MARBLE (a metamorphic rock that sometimes has caves)
- STALACTITE (a cave formation that hangs “tight” to the ceiling)
- STALAGMITE (a cave formation that grows up from the floor)
- SPIDER (many types live in caves)
- WATER (water makes caves)
