This is a common recommended sequence but there is some flexibility on when courses are Completed.* Courses with an *asterisk are from the recommended sequence. Students going to 4 year colleges or students wishing to have a more academic background should complete 4 years of English, 3 years Math, 2 years Foreign Language, 1 year Fine Art and 1-2 College Classes in Concurrent enrollment. There is usually no social science freshman year, and **civics/economics should be saved** until the last year of high school.
